Yes. Our College is an affiliated college to Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram. It follows the syllabus prescribed by the affiliated university. The College follows the semester system under the CBCS structure. At the beginning of each academic year, each of the departments prepare semester-wise curriculum plans with the syllabus and curricular and cocurricular activities to be conducted for the semester. Based on this, the faculty prepare teaching notes every month based on the availability of periods for theory and practicals. - Every parent is informed of the progress of a student. - if a student is irregular in attendance and causes disturbance to the discipline in the college, the students parents are informed about their child and the class teachers with the support of the parents takes necessary steps to improve the students behaviour
