


Minutes of the Meeting:-


- ⇒ A Farmer is a person engaged in agriculture, raising living organisms for food or raw materials.





Based on current scientific evidence, at least 10% of all cancer cases could be prevented with effective primary prevention measures, and further mortality can be reduced through early detection of tumours.






