

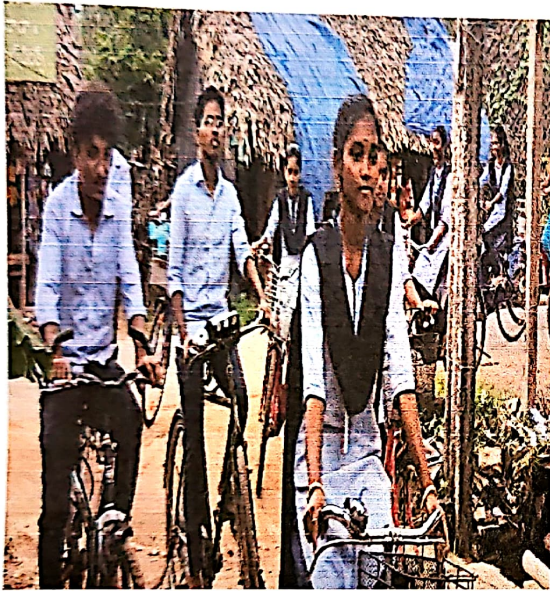

Learning Outcomes:

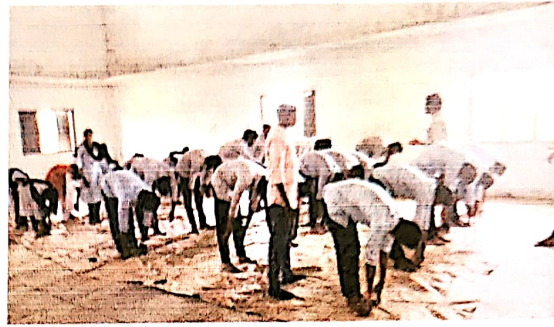
